Notification on MTech Admission through CCMT 2020

All the candidates who are allotted seats at NIT Goa after completion of 3rd Round of Reporting and Special rounds of CCMT and who have paid the required balance fees as applicable to NIT Goa at CCMT are hereby informed that they have to **compulsorily complete online reporting** at the online admission portal of NIT Goa. *The schedule for online reporting at NIT Goa will be notified later.* However, all such candidates shall keep the following documents ready to upload.

The candidates who do not have or are not able to get the **conduct certificate, transfer certificate and migration certificate** presently may submit the same at a later date after online reporting. However, such candidates may write a request letter to Dean (Academic), stating the reason for not submitting these certificates and upload the same on the online admission portal, along with other documents.

However, all the other listed documents (as applicable) are to be submitted without fail. The scanned copies of the following original documents are to be uploaded by the candidate at the time of online reporting for admission at the Institute

1. Provisional admission letter downloaded from the CCMT portal
2. Original GATE score card (2018/2019/2020)
3. Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms (Copy of Aadhar card is compulsory)
4. Original certificate of date of birth issued by competent authority/class X (high school mark sheet) certificate as proof of date of birth
5. Class X (high school) marks sheet
6. Original mark sheet of class XII
7. Original grade/mark sheets of qualifying examination for all semesters
8. Original degree / provisional certificate if degree is completed
9. Original course completion certificate from the Head of the University/Institute if result is awaited
10. An undertaking (in prescribed format) by those candidates whose result is awaited
11. Original certificate of category (OBC-NCL/SC/ST), if applicable, as per Government of India, issued by the competent authority. In case of OBC category, the respective OBC-NCL certificate must be issued on or after April 1, 2020
12. Original income and assets certificate for EWS candidates, if applicable, as per Government of India, issued by the competent authority. The certificate must be issued on or after April 1, 2020.
13. Original certificate for persons with disabilities (PwD), if applicable, issued by the competent authority.
14. Undertaking to be submitted by PwD candidate in the format provided
15. Proof of payment of Institute balance fee to CCMT
16. Passport size photograph.
17. Original conduct certificate from head of the institution last attended
18. Original migration certificate of last institute/university attended
19. Original transfer certificate from the head of the institution last attended

(If any certificate is in language other than Hindi or English, translation of the same in English is to be produced certified by the competent authority as per CCMT norms)

Important Notes

- (1) *Candidates belonging to OBC –NCL or EWS category are required to submit the certificates in the prescribed format. The said certificate must be issued on or after April 1, 2020. The certificates issued earlier than the prescribed date are not acceptable and no affidavit or undertaking in this regard will be acceptable during the online reporting at the Institute. So, all such candidates must arrange to get valid certificates before the online reporting*
- (2) *Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra state have to produce their caste validity certificate. ST certificate from Tamil Nadu state must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer.*
- (3) *The candidates who belong to PwD category must submit the certificate issued from a competent authority in the prescribed format. They also need to submit an undertaking along with the certificate. The prescribed format for the undertaking may be downloaded from the NIT Goa website.*
- (4) *The candidates whose examination for qualifying degree study has not been completed or who are awaiting for their result, must submit a course completion certificate in the prescribed format duly signed by the head of the institute where the qualifying degree is being pursued. A self-declaration in this regard is not acceptable. Such candidates should also submit an undertaking in the prescribed format along with the course completion certificate.*
- (5) **The classes will be conducted in online mode till the pandemic situation improves. The candidates are advised to make necessary arrangement for attending classes in online mode.**

Tentatively classes in online mode are scheduled to start from 5th of October 2020. The actual date of commencement of classes (in online mode) will be notified later in the Institute website.

Candidates should visit the Institute website regularly for further updates.
