ITEM No.BoG.34.4.2: FC-27.4: To Consider and approve the pay protection of Dr. Gopal Mugeraya, Director NIT Goa.

Prof. Gopal Mugeraya, Professor of NIT Surathkal is on lien and joined NIT Goa as the Director on 15.07.2017. His pay has been fixed at Rs.2,10,000/- as per the 7th CPC order. As per the certificate issued by NITK Surathkal (No.1150/NITK-CHE-Estt./2021/B1), Prof. Gopal Mugeraya has been placed in HAG Scale (67000-79000) and the notional pay has been fixed as per the 7th CPC is as under:

In view of the above, the proposal has been put up to FC for kind consideration for pay protection of Prof. Gopal Mugeraya retrospectively as per the norms.

The Certificate from NITK Suratkal vide reference number: 1150/NITK-CHE-Estt./2021/B1 is placed as the reference in Annexure FC-27.A2.

Prof. Gopal Mugeraya Reached Highest Pay in Level-15 of Pay Matrix, pay fixation and due amount computed from July 2019 to September 2021 is shown in a Table (Annexure FC-27.A3). As per the computation, the net arrears amount due from July 2019 to Sept. 2021 is Rs. 1,46,322 (Rs. One lakh fortysix thousand three hundred twenty two only). FC may consider and approve the same.

Resolution of FC: As per DoPT's OM no. 6/8/2009-Estt(Pay II) dated 17th June , 2010, Prof. Gopal Mugeraya, The Director NIT Goa is entitled for pay protection. The FC approved the proposal as envisaged in the DoPT's OM.

Prof. Gopal Mugeraya may be allowed to draw Special Allowance of Rs.5000/- only if he opts for the pay of Rs.2,10,000/- (fixed) (previously Rs.75000/- in 6^{th} CPC) attached to the post of Director, NIT. However, Special Allowance will not be admissible to him if he opts to draw pay of Rs.2,24,100 [i.e.Rs.79000/- of 6^{th} CPC] plus Deputation (Duty) allowance. Further, if he opts to draw pay of his parent post. Basic pay plus Deputation (Duty) Allowance should not exceed Rs.2,25,000/-.

ITEM No.BoG.34.4.3: FC-27.5: Approval for the upgradation of administrative and technical staff through DPC

The total number of Non-Faculty posts sanctioned for NIT Goa in 2010 is 42, for a student strength relevant to three departments (30 each) started then. P.G (M.Tech) program in three department was started in the academic year 2014-15. Since, then we have been requesting for sanctioning additional posts, based on the growing student intake. However, we have not received any communication on the sanction of additional posts till date. This has eventually led to the stagnation of Non-Faculty employees in the same post for more than 5 years to 9 years (maximum). The timely promotion of the deserving employee will definitely boost the morale of the employee to perform better.

It is requested to kindly approve the upgradation of GP for the non-faculty posts to its next higher level with pay protection, through DPC following all the stipulated norms

Resolution of FC: FC has noted that several non-faculty members are stagnated in the same GP for several years. FC also understands the need for upgradation of their GP through DPC to next higher level. As the institution does not have the vacant sanctioned posts in the higher GP, it has been resolved that the sanction of additional posts based on the present students strength will be taken up in fast track mode by MoE.
