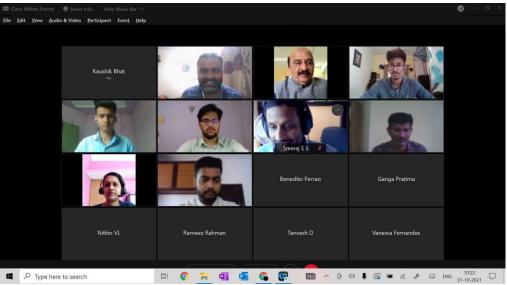
Utkranti 2021 received astounding participation and was a Grand Success!

INAUGURAL CEREMONY

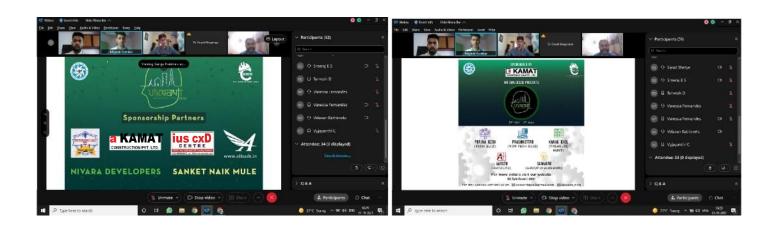

PRASHNOTTAR - NON TECHNICAL QUIZ

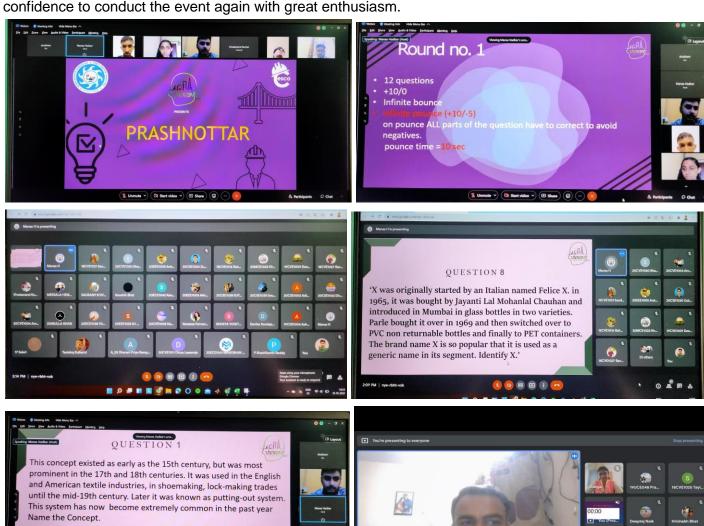
Prashnottar was a virtual quiz event that comes under the Non-Technical event of Utkranti'21.

It was a 2 round (preliminary and final) competition that covered the area of logical reasoning, current affairs, and general knowledge. There were a total of 41 participants of which 6 participants qualified for the final round.

The first round of competition started at 2 pm. In this round, the logical intellect of the participants was debriefed. Every participant was given a set of 15 questions and they had to answer in 30 min in Google form. Questions were shown by sharing the screen in Google meet.

The second round was the 'Finale Round' which consisted of three sections. The questions were set such that all Engineering students from all years could participate and answer. The event had one quiz master who made sure that the whole process went smoothly and the whole event was conducted in the proper timetable. The scorekeeping and time management were assigned to volunteers. The highest scorer of the final round was awarded as the winner and the second-highest as runner-up.

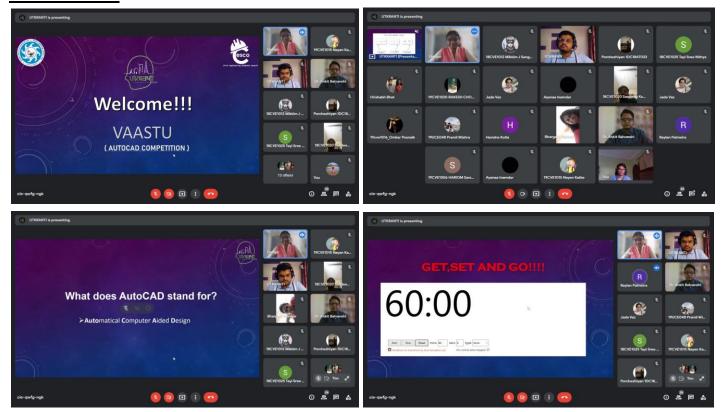
We received lots of positive feedback from the participants which paid off our hard work & boosted our confidence to conduct the event again with great enthusiasm.

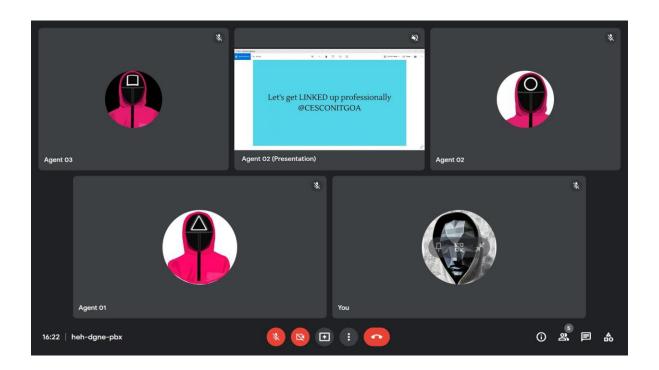

KANAK KHOJ - ONLINE TREASURE HUNT

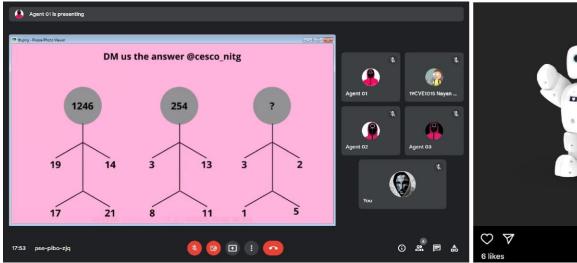

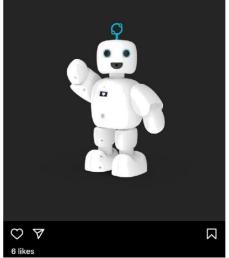

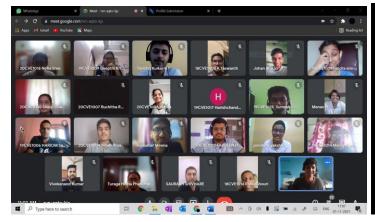


PRAJNA KOSH - TECHNICAL QUIZ

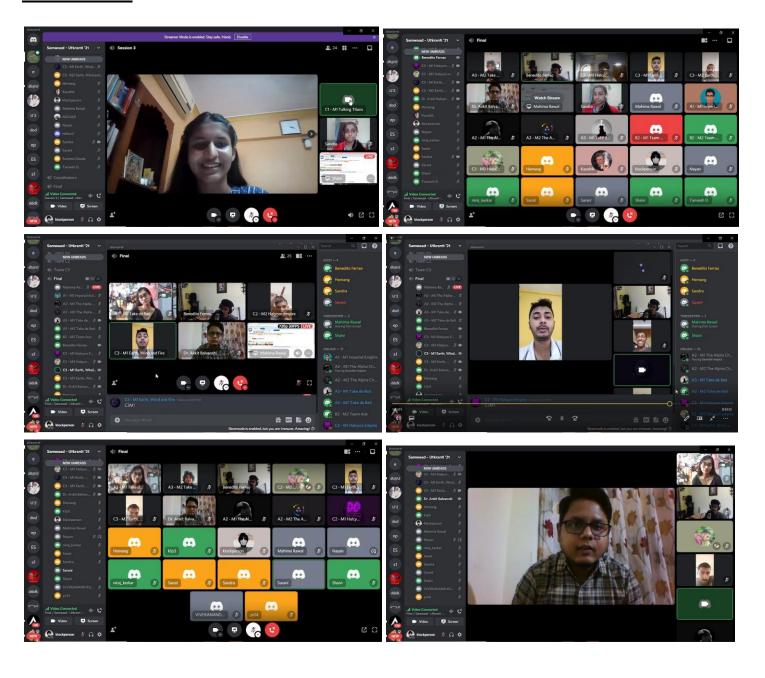

The Dialogue of the Duo - Samwaad was a team competition, of 2 members each. A total of 8 teams from different colleges around the states participated. The fixture was set into 3 sessions, one of which was for the 3 teams from the civil engineering branch competing against each other. The other 2 sessions were for the 5 teams from other courses of study. Round 1 was concluded in 1hr20min, which gave us the top 3 teams for Round 2 - Finals. The topic of the Discussion for Round 2 was "Does deadline destroy creativity?" and 21 minutes of an insightful session of different perspectives on the topic gave us the winner - Team Take de Bait and the runner up - Team Earth, Fire & Wind. In the post-final session, the judges shared their views on the same topic and gave a few helpful feedback for the participants for future competitions.

VAASTU - FINALE ROUND

Top eight finalists were selected for the final round. The round began with an interactive session to test the creativity of the participants. Participants were shown some pictures and asked to interpret the image. After the interactive session concluded the participants were briefed with the rules and guidelines. This round the participants were given a problem statement and asked to draw the design using their own imagination. All the finalists were proctored individually, allotting them a meet link to join where the co-ordinator was present. The participants were instructed to share their entire screen and then the timer was started which was set for sixty minutes. After the problem statement was disclosed the participants were given five minutes to think and then start designing.
