A. Addendum in Minor program rules

Students who have cleared all the courses of the first and second semesters in the first attempt and have obtained a $CGPA \geq 7.0$ upto 2nd semester are eligible to register for minor courses. Students are allotted Minor specialization, based on their CGPA and minor preference order.

- 1. In case of a 2nd Semester CGPA tie, the merit list shall be prepared based on the CGPA obtained till 3rd Semester for the tie applicants.
- 2. If there is also a 3rd Semester CGPA tie, the merit list shall be prepared based on the JEE (Main), All India Rank (AIR) for the tie applicants.

B. Modification in Highest Grade in Re-Exam and Summer Term for B.Tech OLD and NEW Schemes

Presently, the highest grade to be given in Re-Exam and Summer Term was fixed to 'C'. We received feedback from many faculty members that, certain students are performing well, particularly in Summer term; and deserve to get a grade higher than 'C', as they are redoing the course completely and few of them are performing very well.

In view of the above, it is requested to kindly allow the course coordinator to provide the grade as per the performance of the student both in Re-Exam and Summer term and allow the highest grade that can be awarded to be restricted to 'A'.

D. Procedure for Correction of Tabulation Error

It is proposed to modify the tabulation error correction procedure, as given below:

Present Rule: Once grades are published, changes if any, will be allowed in case of tabulation errors only. A request for re-tabulation can be made by student to the course teacher within 2 days of result publication. A request for changes in grade due to tabulation errors (if any) can be made by the teacher of the course, by forwarding the request through the DCC to Exam cell.

Proposed Rule: Once grades are published, changes if any, will be allowed in case of tabulation errors only. A request for re-tabulation can be made by student to the course teacher within 2 days of result publication. A request for changes in grade due to tabulation errors (if any) can be made by the teacher of the course, upon Director's approval (duly forwarded by DCC, Exam Cell, Dean (Acad)).

Presently, at NIT Goa we have almost equal number of regular and temporary faculty members. Regular faculty members are supported by CPDA and Institute grant for filing patents, through which they get financial aid in carrying out research activities. It is proposed to take few steps to encourage the faculty (on temporary basis) to continue their research work, improve their professional profile and contribute to the Institute's growth thereby.

The following financial assistance is proposed for the faculty (on temporary basis) for the kind consideration of the Senate:

- 1. If a temporary faculties' paper, as first/corresponding author, is accepted/published in an SCI/SCI-E/SSCI/SCOPUS indexed journal, with NIT Goa's affiliation, the faculty can avail one of the following facilities:
 - a. A support upto Rs. 50,000/- per financial year, for meeting Journal page overlength charges (or)
 - b. A support upto Rs. 50,000/- per financial year, for presenting a paper in SCOPUS indexed/reputed international conference either in India or Foreign country. The financial support will be provided towards registration fees, full/partial travel, local transport, accommodation and food. Institute shall also extend required documentational support while availing international travel grants from other funding sources like - DST, etc. The conference paper evaluation committee will be as per CPDA guidelines. Special casual leave upto 10 days/Calander year will be provided to the faculty for presenting the international conference paper.
 - c. The financial support for Journal/Conference paper will be extended to a faculty even after his/her discontinuation from NIT Goa, provided the paper acceptance

happens during his/her tenure at NIT Goa. The support will be valid for a period of One year from the date of paper acceptance.

- 2. Faculty are also encouraged to publish Indian patents. The IP rights will be with NIT Goa and the patent will be fully funded by the Institute.
- 3. Institute shall provide funding for basic professional membership fees in reputed societies upto an amount of Rs. 10,000/-. This will help the faculty to be active in research and also can avail discounts in conference registration fees. Evaluation of the professional society/body will be done by a duly constituted committee.
