INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME (SIP) 2026

Eligibility Criteria

- Students must meet the following conditions to apply:
 - **B.Tech./BE** students completing the **Second/Third year** (or Fourth/Sixth Semester).
 - **B.Arch.** students completing the **Fourth/Sixth/Eighth Semester**
 - **M.Tech./ME/M.Sc./M.Plan/MBA/MA/MS** students completing the **First Year** (or Second Semester)
 - **BSc./ BS** students completing Second year / Third year
- Minimum CGPA: **6.5** (out of 10) or **65% aggregate marks** (up to the latest published semester results).
- Candidates must be **regular full-time students with no back papers and no disciplinary actions** from their parent institute.
- Students of NIT Goa are not eligible to apply as this is a scheme exclusively for students outside NIT Goa. (Willing students from NIT Goa are requested to approach the faculty member individually)

Step 1: Registration Process

1. Document Preparation: Ensure you have the following documents in **PDF format** before starting the application:

- NIT Goa SIP Application Form, One-page resume, Undertaking Form, Bonafide certificate from the parent institute (endorsed by HOD/Institution Head in Institute Letter Head), Tenth marksheet, twelfth marksheet, consolidated or individual grade cards showing current CGPA and Institute ID card (merged as a single PDF, less than 10 MB)

2. APAAR ID Requirement

- All students applying for the Summer Internship at NIT Goa are required to have an APAAR ID (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry).
- If you already have an APAAR ID: Keep it readily available for submission during the internship application process.

- For students who have not yet created an APAAR ID:
Please follow the steps below to generate your APAAR ID:
 - Sign up on the official APAAR portal or install the DigiLocker app on Mobile Phone.
 - Create a DigiLocker account using your mobile number.
 - Provide consent for sharing your Aadhaar card details when prompted.
 - Search for APAAR in DigiLocker app.
 - Enter your academic details, including:
 - Institution Name
 - Enrolment Number
 - Course and Branch Information
 - After submission and successful verification, your APAAR ID card will be generated and accessible through your DigiLocker account.

3. How to register

- Click on the given link ([Google Form](#)) to proceed with the registration.

4. Enter the mandatory details

- Enter all the mandatory details to complete your application & submit.

5. Select Preference

- Area and Mentor
- Make sure you have submitted the preferences before final submission

Step 2: Selection and Confirmation

1. Applicants are requested to check the NIT Goa website for updates regarding the SIP 2026
2. Selection will be done by the department

Important Notes

1. Multiple applications by a single applicant are **not permitted** and will result in rejection
2. One can apply for an internship in **only one department** at NIT Goa
3. During the application, one will have to select the desired internship duration, the faculty member and area of interest

4. Registration fee (Rs.500) is Non-refundable and it needs to be paid before joining the programme
 5. Incorrect details may lead to rejection of the application

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Important Dates

1. Last Date of Receipt of Application on 10 April 2026
2. Scrutiny of applications/ Selection process by the respective department
3. Intimation of selection on 15 April 2026
4. Date of reporting 15 May 2026 (Reporting date may vary)
5. SIP will be between May 15 and July 15, 2026

*Note: Candidates are advised to check the website regularly. Once the list of shortlisted interns is published, Information about the further process will be notified on the website. Joining date may vary depending on the convenience of the faculty and the Intern but it must not be after May 25th, 2026.

Facilities:

- Fellowship or other financial assistance will not be provided
- Laboratory, Library Facilities (without borrowing) and internet facilities
- Medical facility (consultation with doctor at Institute dispensary)
- Accommodation cost -200/ (per day/per person)
- Food is Available in campus on payment basis

General Instructions for Students applying for internship

- Any query related to internship should be addressed to the respective department internship mentor – mentioned on the website.
- Intern attendance will be recorded daily
- Interns are expected to achieve tangible outcomes by the end of the internship. These may include, but are not limited to, a conference or journal publication, product or technology

development, or patent filing. Interns are also required to deliver a seminar in their respective departments.

- At the end of the internship, interns must submit a detailed report to the department internship mentor
- The award of the internship certificate is subject to a satisfactory recommendation from the assigned mentor, HoD & Dean
- Interns are required to strictly adhere to all rules and regulations – both written and verbal – prescribed by NIT Goa. Any instance of misconduct or malpractice reported during the internship will lead to immediate termination of the internship, along with appropriate disciplinary action as deemed necessary by the Institute NIT Goa, including its faculty and staff, will not be held responsible for any accidents or injuries that may occur during the course of the internship program at NIT Goa.
